 Fewer trees grow on the shadier south side of 16th and 17th Ave.


The new Mount Royal West construction does not yet have trees.






Summertime Sun and Wind patterns : 10:00am and 4:00pm


Shorter shadows, more direct sunlight, and less wind.






Wintertime Sun and Wind patterns: 10:00am and 4:00pm


Longer shadows, less sunlight , and more wind.










